Action: NOP/NOI to prepare an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the City of Ridgecrest New Wastewater Treatment Plant

Summary: The City of Ridgecrest is preparing an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the City of Ridgecrest's New Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). A Wastewater Treatment Facility Plan was prepared in 2014 to evaluate two project alternatives that could accommodate existing and future growth within the City and China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station. The EIR will fully evaluate the potential environmental impacts associated with Phase 1 of the two Project Alternatives, as well as the No Project Alternative.

Phase 1 of the New Wastewater Treatment Plant Project would involve the construction and operation of a new 3.6-million-gallon-per-day (MGD) wastewater treatment plant. Phase 2 of the New Wastewater Treatment Plant Project will require upgrades to treat up to 5.4 MGD. Because, there is no timeframe available for the construction of Phase 2, potential environmental impacts resulting from Phase 2 will be evaluated under subsequent environmental documentation.

Dates: Comments concerning the scope of the analysis must be received by July 30, 2015. The Draft EIR is expected in October 2015 and the Final EIR in January 2016.

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

Project Background:

The existing wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) located on the China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station (NAWS) has been in service for many years and is in need of significant repair to maintain its functionality. Fundamental portions of the plant process components are deteriorated, and certain conditions may be considered hazardous. The WWTP is adequate for water recycling. Considering the condition of the existing WWTP, the existing facility will not continue to adequately serve the City and NAWS without substantial improvements or replacements. Additionally, the existing WWTP has approached its permitted capacity of 3.6 million gallons per day (MGD). In 1993, flows reached 3.3 MGD, before population began to decline in the mid 1990s. Current flows through the WWTP average approximately 2.2 MGD; however, growth will cause flows to approach the permitted capacity again.

Proposed Project Alternatives:

The EIR will fully evaluate the potential environmental impacts associated with Phase 1 of the two Project Alternatives, as well as a No Project Alternative, in compliance with CEQA.

Phase 1

- Alternative 1 would involve the construction and operation of a 3.6-MGD wastewater treatment plant adjacent to the existing WWTP at the China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station (NAWS) site which is located northeast of the intersection of Pole Line Road and Knox Road. This alternative also requires the operation of existing wastewater disposal ponds at the NAWS site and City site, and the construction of additional ponds at the City and San Bernardino County sites which are located south of Church Avenue and west and east San Bernardino Boulevard.
- Alternative 2 would involve the construction and operation of a 3.6-MGD wastewater treatment plant adjacent to the existing WWTP ponds at the City site which is located approximately 1,000 feet south of Church Avenue and 1,000 feet west of San Bernardino Boulevard. This alternative also requires the operation of existing wastewater disposal ponds at the NAWS site and City site, and the construction of additional ponds at the City and San Bernardino County sites which are located south of Church Avenue and west and east San Bernardino Boulevard.
- The No Project Alternative involves the continued operation of the existing wastewater treatment plant and wastewater disposal ponds which are located at the NAWS and City sites.

The construction and operation of a 3.6-MGD wastewater treatment plant would generally involve the following facilities:

- Influent pumps and headworks and screening facilities
- Aeration basins and clarifiers

- Bio-solids handling facilities
- Bio-solids digestion
- Solids dewatering facilities
- Wastewater percolation/ evaporation ponds
- Construction of new wastewater treatment ponds for storage and percolation/evaporation
- Emergency power
- Operations buildings, maintenance building, and electrical/boiler building
- Various site improvements (including paved access roads, parking areas, security fencing, storm drains, gravel surfacing, and related improvements)

Disposal of treated effluent would potentially involve the following methods:

- Evaporation and percolation using existing and new ponds at the NAWS and City sites.
- Alfalfa irrigation with secondary effluent at the City site.
- Golf course and other landscaping irrigation using recycled water meeting Title 22 standards for unrestricted use.

Phase 2 of the New Wastewater Treatment Plant Project will require upgrades to treat up to 5.4 mgd. As there is currently no timeline for the construction of Phase 2, potential environmental impacts resulting from Phase 2 will be evaluated under subsequent environmental documentation.


Potential Environmental Impacts:

The EIR will fully analyze potential environmental impacts associated with Phase 1 of the Proposed Project Alternatives. Specific areas of analysis will include all resource categories included in Appendix G to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, as follows: aesthetics, agricultural resources, air quality, greenhouse gases and global climate change, biological resources, cultural resources, geology and soils, hazards, hydrology and water quality, land use, mineral resources, noise, population and housing, public services, recreation, transportation and traffic, and utilities and service systems.

If you believe that any of the Proposed Project Alternatives could result in specific significant impacts, we invite you to describe the nature of those impacts, as well as offer feasible and reasonable mitigation for such impacts that should be considered in the EIR.

Scoping Process:

This NOP initiates the scoping process, which guides the development of the EIR. It is important that reviewers provide their comments at such times and in such a manner that they are useful in the lead agency's preparation of this EIR. Therefore, comments should be provided prior to the close of the comment period and should clearly articulate the reviewer's concerns and comments regarding the potential environmental impacts that may result from the Proposed Project. Comments received in response to this solicitation, including names and addresses of those who comment, will be part of the public record for this Proposed Project. Comments submitted anonymously will also be accepted and considered.

Dear Mr. Bracken:

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Department) has reviewed the NOP submitted by the City of Ridgecrest (City) for the above Project. The Project would involve the construction and operation of a new 3.6-million-gallon-per-day (MGD) wastewater treatment plant (WWTP). In 2014, a Wastewater Treatment Facility Plan was prepared to evaluate two (2) Project alternatives that could accommodate existing and future growth within the City and China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station.

In Alternative 1, the new WWTP would be constructed adjacent to the existing WWTP at the China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station, which is located northeast of the intersection of Pole Line Road and Knox Road. This alternative would also require the operation of the existing City wastewater disposal ponds and those on the China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station, as well as the construction of additional ponds at the City and San Bernardino County sites. These new ponds would be located south of Church Avenue and west and east of San Bernardino Boulevard.

In Alternative 2, the new WWTP would be constructed adjacent to the existing WWTP ponds at the City site which is located approximately 1,000 feet south of Church Avenue and 1,000 feet west of San Bernardino Boulevard. This alternative would also require the operation of the existing City wastewater disposal ponds and those on the China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station, as well as the construction of additional ponds at the City and San Bernardino County sites, as described above.

The Department recognizes that the City has determined that implementation of the proposed Project could result in impacts to native vegetation and/or sensitive biological resources potentially present in the Project sites, and impacts will be further analyzed in the draft EIR prepared for the Project. This letter is intended to provide early guidance to assist the City and the Project biologists regarding Department concerns and recommended Project avoidance, minimization, and mitigation measures to be included in the draft EIR.

The Department is concerned that construction activities could result in impacts to special-status species known to occur in close proximity and/or on the proposed Project sites including, but not limited to, nesting birds; the State and federally endangered Mohave tui chub (*Siphateles bicolor mohavensis*); the State and federally threatened desert tortoise (*Gopherus agassizii*); the State threatened Mohave ground squirrel (*Xerospermophilus mohavensis*); the State Species of Special Concern burrowing owl (*Athene cunicularia*), American badger (*Taxidea taxus*), and Le Conte's thrasher (*Toxostoma lecontei*); the State protected furbearing mammal desert kit fox (*Vulpes macrotis ssp. macrotis*); and the California Rare Plant Rank 1B.2 Clokey's crypthantha (*Cryptantha clokeyi*).

The proposed Project sites include areas that have appropriate habitat for nesting, denning, foraging, or colonization opportunities for the above species; therefore, a reconnaissance-level assessment of the Project sites conducted by a qualified wildlife biologist and a qualified botanist is warranted. In the event that burrows, dens, and/or vegetation that could support special-status species are present within or immediately adjacent to the Project sites, focused biological surveys then need to be conducted by qualified biologists during the appropriate survey period(s) and prior to Project approval by the City to determine if these species are present and if they could be impacted by the proposed Project. Survey results can then be used to inform any mitigation, minimization, and avoidance measures to be included in the draft EIR prepared for this Project and any potential permitting needs. We recommend that our suggested avoidance and minimization measures be included in the draft EIR as enforceable mitigation measures as appropriate. Our comments follow.

Department Jurisdiction

Trustee Agency Authority: The Department is a Trustee Agency with responsibility under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for commenting on projects that could impact plant and wildlife resources. Pursuant to Fish and Game Code Section 1802, the Department has jurisdiction over the conservation, protection, and management of fish, wildlife, native plants, and the habitats necessary for biologically sustainable populations of those species. As a Trustee Agency for fish and wildlife resources, the Department is responsible for providing, as available, biological expertise to review and comment upon environmental documents and impacts arising from project activities, as those terms are used under CEQA (Division 13 [commencing with Section 21000] of the Public Resources Code).

Responsible Agency Authority: The Department has regulatory authority over projects that could result in the "take" of any species listed by the State as threatened or endangered, pursuant to Fish and Game Code Section 2081. If the Project could result in the take of any species listed as threatened or endangered under the California Endangered Species Act (CESA), the Department may need to issue an Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the Project. CEQA requires a Mandatory Finding of Significance if a

project is likely to substantially impact threatened or endangered species (sections 21001(c), 21083, Guidelines sections 15380, 15064, 15065). Impacts must be avoided or mitigated to less than significant levels unless the CEQA Lead Agency makes and supports a Statement of Overriding Consideration (SOC). The CEQA Lead Agency's SOC does not eliminate the Project proponent's obligation to comply with Fish and Game Code Section 2080. The Project has the potential to reduce the number or restrict the range of endangered, rare, or threatened species (as defined in Section 15380 of CEQA).

Unlisted Species: Species of plants and animals need not be officially listed as Endangered, Rare, or Threatened (E, R, or T) on any State or Federal list to be considered E, R, or T under CEQA. If a species can be shown to meet the criteria for E, R, or T, as specified in the CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15380), it should be fully considered in the environmental analysis for the Project.

Bird Protection: The Department has jurisdiction over actions that could result in the disturbance or destruction of active nest sites or the unauthorized take of birds. Fish and Game Code sections that protect birds, their eggs, and nests include sections 3503 (regarding unlawful take, possession or needless destruction of the nest or eggs of any bird), 3503.5 (regarding the take, possession or destruction of any birds-of-prey or their nests or eggs), and 3513 (regarding unlawful take of any migratory nongame bird).

Protected Furbearing Mammals: The Department has jurisdiction over furbearing mammals pursuant to Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 460. This Section states, "Fisher, marten, river otter, desert kit fox and red fox may not be taken at any time"; therefore, the Department cannot authorize their take.

Lake or Streambed Alteration (LSA): The Department also has regulatory authority with regard to activities occurring in streams and/or lakes that could adversely affect any fish or wildlife resource, pursuant to Fish and Game Code sections 1600 *et seq.* If a Project could substantially divert or obstruct the natural flow of any river, stream or lake; substantially change or use any material from the bed, channel, or bank of, any river, stream, or lake; or deposit or dispose of debris, waste, or other material containing crumbled, flaked, or ground pavement where it may pass into any river, stream, or lake, notification of the lake or streambed alteration to the Department is required. If Project activities could impact any water feature, the Department recommends that Project proponents consult with the Lake and Streambed Alteration Program before ground-breaking activities and submit a Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration to the Department, to comply with Fish and Game Code section 1602. It is important to note that the Department is required to comply with CEQA in the issuance of an LSA Agreement. Therefore, for efficiency in environmental compliance, the Department recommends that the stream disturbance be described, and mitigation for the

disturbance be developed as part of the environmental review process. This will reduce the need for the Department to require extensive additional environmental review to issue an LSA Agreement. For additional information on notification requirements, please contact staff in the Lake and Streambed Alteration Program at (559) 243-4593.

Water Pollution: Pursuant to Fish and Game Code Section 5650, it is unlawful to deposit in, permit to pass into, or place where it can pass into the "Waters of the State" any substance or material deleterious to fish, plant life, or bird life, including non-native species. The Department recommends that the draft EIR fully address potential pollutants to Waters of the State in the environmental analysis for the Project. The Regional Water Quality Control Board also has jurisdiction regarding discharge and pollution to Waters of the State including storm water runoff into surface waters.

Potential Project Impacts and Recommendations

Desert Tortoise: The proposed Project sites are within desert tortoise range and have areas that contain suitable habitat for the species. The Department recommends that surveys be performed by qualified biologists during the appropriate survey period following the protocol contained in "Preparing for any action that may occur within the range of the Mojave desert tortoise (*Gopherus agassizii*)" (USFWS 2010). The Department advises that survey results be submitted to both the Department and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS). Consultation with the Department and the USFWS to develop avoidance, minimization, and mitigation measures is recommended if surveys indicate the presence or potential presence of desert tortoise. If take could occur as a result of Project implementation, acquisition of a State ITP may be warranted prior to initiating ground-disturbing activities.

The Department also recommends consulting with the USFWS on potential impacts to federally listed desert tortoise. Take under the Federal Endangered Species Act (FESA) is more broadly defined than CESA; take under FESA also includes significant habitat modification or degradation that could result in death or injury to a listed species by interfering with essential behavioral patterns such as breeding, foraging, or nesting. Consultation with the USFWS in order to comply with FESA is advised well in advance of Project implementation.

Mohave Ground Squirrel (MGS): MGS have been documented within the Alternative 1 Project site and in close proximity to the Alternative 2 Project site (CDFW 2015). In order to implement full avoidance for MGS, the Department recommends that a 50-foot no-disturbance buffer be employed around all burrows that could be used by MGS. If this is not feasible, the Department advises that a qualified permitted biologist conduct protocol surveys for MGS following the methods described in the "Mohave Ground Squirrel Survey Guidelines" (CDFG 2003) at all Project-related impact areas during the appropriate survey season prior to Project implementation. The Department recommends that the results of the MGS surveys be submitted to the

Department, and that consultation with the Department occurs to develop avoidance, minimization, and mitigation measures. If take could occur as a result of Project implementation, acquisition of a State ITP may be warranted prior to initiating ground-disturbing activities. Alternatively, the Project applicant has the option of assuming presence for this species and securing a State ITP, which would authorize incidental take of State-listed species during Project implementation.

Burrowing Owl: Burrowing owls have been documented adjacent to the Alternative 1 Project site and in close proximity to the Alternative 2 Project site (CDFW, 2015). To avoid impacts to the species, the Department recommends that focused surveys be conducted following the survey methodology developed by the California Burrowing Owl Consortium (CBOC 1993) well in advance of any ground disturbance associated with Project construction as well as a 10-day prior to disturbance pre-construction survey effort. If any ground-disturbing activities will occur during the burrowing owl nesting season (approximately February 1 through August 31), and potential burrowing owl burrows are present within the Project footprint, implementation of avoidance measures are warranted. In the event that burrowing owls are found, the Department's "Staff Report on Burrowing Owl Mitigation" (CDFG 2012) (Staff Report) recommends that impacts to occupied burrows be avoided by implementation of no-disturbance buffer zones, unless a qualified biologist approved by the Department verifies through non-invasive methods that either: 1-) the birds have not begun egg laying and incubation; or 2) that juveniles from the occupied burrows are foraging independently and are capable of independent survival.

Failure to implement the recommended buffer zones could cause adult burrowing owls to abandon the nest, cause eggs or young to be directly impacted (crushed), and/or result in reproductive failure, in violation of Fish and Game Code and the Migratory Bird Treaty Act.

If the Project proponent proposes to evict burrowing owls that may be present, the Department recommends passive relocation during the non-breeding season. We recommend that the draft EIR describe all avoidance measures that would be employed in the event that owls are found on the Project sites, as well as methods that would be used to evict owls from burrows. We also recommend that the draft EIR specify how the impact of evicting owls would be mitigated to a less than significant level. The Staff Report recommends that foraging habitat be acquired and permanently protected to

offset the loss of foraging and burrow habitat. The Department also recommends replacement of occupied burrows with artificial burrows at a ratio of 1 burrow collapsed to 1 artificial burrow constructed (1:1) as mitigation for the potentially significant impact of evicting a burrowing owl if a biologist knowledgeable with the biology and natural history of the species determines that suitable burrows are a potential limiting factor for the species.

Protected Furbearing Mammals: The proposed Project sites are within desert kit fox range and have areas that provide habitat for the species; as such, the Project has the potential to impact this species. The desert kit fox is protected under Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 460, which prohibits take of the species at any time. The Department recommends that the avoidance measures within the USFWS “Standardized recommendations for protection of the San Joaquin kit fox prior to or during ground disturbance” (2011) be followed and that surveys be conducted accordingly and prior to commencing any Project-related ground-disturbing activities. If any active or potential dens are found on the Project sites during these surveys, consultation with the Department would be warranted for guidance on take avoidance measures for the desert kit fox.

Special-Status Plant Species: There is potential for multiple special-status plant species to occur on or adjacent to the Project sites. The Department recommends that the Project sites be surveyed for special-status plants by a qualified botanist following the “Protocols for Surveying and Evaluating Impacts to Special Status Native Plant Populations and Natural Communities” (CDFG 2009). This protocol, which is intended to maximize detectability, includes the identification of reference populations to facilitate the likelihood of field investigations occurring during the appropriate floristic period. In the absence of protocol-level surveys being performed, additional surveys might be necessary. Further, the Department recommends that special-status plant species be avoided whenever possible by delineation and observing a no-disturbance buffer of at least 50 feet from the outer edge of the plant population(s) or specific habitat type(s) required by special-status plant species. If buffers cannot be maintained, then consultation with the Department may be warranted to determine appropriate minimization and mitigation measures for impacts to special-status plant species. If a State- or federally listed plant species is identified during botanical surveys, it is recommended that consultation with the Department and/or the USFWS be conducted to determine permitting needs.

Nesting Birds: The trees, shrubs, and grasses within and in the vicinity of the Project sites likely provide nesting habitat for songbirds and raptors. The Department encourages Project implementation to occur during the non-nesting bird season. If ground-disturbing activities must occur during the breeding season (February through mid-September), the Project applicant is responsible for ensuring that implementation of the Project does not result in any violation of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act or relevant Fish and Game Codes as referenced above. Prior to work commencing, including

staging, clearing, and grubbing, the Department recommends that surveys for active nests be conducted by a qualified wildlife biologist no more than 10 days prior to the start of the Project commencing and that the surveys be conducted in a sufficient area around the work site to identify any nests that are present and to determine their status. A sufficient area means any nest within an area that could potentially be affected by the Project. In addition to direct impacts, such as nest destruction, nests might be affected by noise, vibration, odors, and movement of workers or equipment. Identified nests should be continuously surveyed for the first 24 hours prior to any construction-related activities to establish a behavioral baseline. Once work commences, all nests should be continuously monitored to detect any behavioral changes as a result of the Project. If behavioral changes are observed, the work causing that change should cease and the Department consulted for additional avoidance and minimization measures.

The Department also recommends a minimum no-disturbance buffer of 250 feet around active nests of non-listed bird species and a 500 foot no-disturbance buffer around the nests of non-listed raptors until the breeding season has ended, or until a qualified biologist has determined that the birds have fledged and are no longer reliant upon the nest or parental care for survival. Variance from these no-disturbance buffers may be implemented when there is compelling biological or ecological reason to do so, such as when the Project area would be concealed from a nest site by topography. Any variance from these buffers is advised to be supported by a qualified wildlife biologist and it is recommended the Department be notified in advance of implementation of a no disturbance buffer variance.

NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF A DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE CITY OF RIDGECREST NEW WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY, CITY OF RIDGECREST, STATE CLEARINGHOUSE NO. 2014051091, KERN COUNTY

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Lahontan Region (Water Board) staff received the Notice of Preparation (NOP) of a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the City of Ridgecrest (City) Project on July 2, 2015. The NOP was prepared by the Provost & Pritchard Consulting Group on behalf of the City and submitted in compliance with provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The existing City wastewater treatment / water reclamation plant is located on China Lake Naval Air Weapons Station (NAWS) and treats sewage collected from both the City and naval base. The Ridgecrest Wastewater Treatment Facility, the Ridgecrest Reclamation Irrigation site, and the Biosolids site are all currently regulated separately under the existing Board Order Nos. and WDID Nos.

The Reclamation Irrigation site has recently failed to provide coliform data, and exceeded flow limitations back in 2009. Around the Ridgecrest Wastewater Treatment Facility, groundwater has currently exceeded secondary maximum contaminant level (MCLs) for Total Dissolved Solids, and the related constituents, chloride and electrical conductivity.

Outdated infrastructure and current demands have shown that the current capacity of 3.6 million gallons per day (MGD) may be insufficient to meet the City's needs. The City

plans to prepare a DEIR that will evaluate the potential environmental impacts associated with Phase 1 of the three following Project alternatives:

1. Alternative 1 - Construct and operate a 3.6 MGD wastewater treatment plant adjacent to the existing wastewater treatment plant located on the NAWS in conjunction with using the existing wastewater disposal ponds at the NAWS and constructing additional ponds near the City's agricultural field south of Church Avenue and on both sides of San Bernardino Boulevard.
2. Alternative 2 - Construct and operate a new 3.6 MGD wastewater treatment plant adjacent to the former wastewater treatment plant site south of Church Avenue and west of San Bernardino Boulevard in conjunction with the disposal ponds at NAWS and the City site.
3. Alternative 3 - No Project Alternative to continue operation of the existing wastewater treatment plant and disposal ponds.

Phase 2 of the New Wastewater Treatment Plant would upgrade and expand the plant capacity to 5.4 MGD. There is currently no timeline for Phase 2. Therefore the planned DEIR would not evaluate impacts associated with Phase 2.

Water Board staff, acting as a responsible agency, is providing these comments to specify the scope and content of the environmental information germane to our statutory responsibilities pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 14, section 15096. We encourage the City to consider our comments in an effort to protect waters of the State and maintain water quality in the Lahontan Region.

WATER BOARD'S AUTHORITY

All groundwater and surface waters are considered waters of the State. Surface waters include streams, lakes, ponds, and wetlands, and may be ephemeral, intermittent, or perennial. All waters of the State are protected under California law. State law assigns responsibility for protection of water quality in the Lahontan Region to the Lahontan Water Board. Some waters of the State are also waters of the U.S. The Federal Clean Water Act (CWA) provides additional protection for those waters of the State that are also waters of the U.S. In the Indian Wells Valley, Water Board staff believes it is unlikely there are federal waters of the U.S. present.

RECYCLED WATER USES

The State Water Resources Control Board adopted the Recycled Water Policy in February 2009 (effective May 14, 2009, and amended January 22, 2013, Resolution Nos. 2009-0011 and 2013-0003, respectively). The purpose of the policy is to increase the use of recycled water from municipal wastewater sources, in a manner that implements state and federal water quality laws, as a means towards achieving sustainable local water supplies. The Recycled Water Policy establishes goals and mandates for recycled water use. The mandates are to increase the use of recycled water from the amount used over 2002 levels by one million acre-feet per year by 2020

and by two million acre-feet per year by 2030. Incentives for implementing recycled water projects include grant opportunities and priority funding.

In July 2009, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted General Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Landscape Irrigation Uses of Municipal Recycled Water WQO-2009-0006-DWQ (General Permit). For those eligible, the General Permit allows the use of recycled water for landscape irrigation. Approved uses include the following: parks, greenbelts, and playgrounds; school yards; athletic fields; golf courses; cemeteries; commercial and industrial landscaping; and freeway, highway, and street landscaping. Recycled water uses for residential landscaping are generally not allowed under this General Permit, but will be considered by the Water Board on a case-by-case basis.

There is also General WDRs for Recycled Water Use WQO-2014-0090-DWQ which regulates the use of recycled water (treated wastewater) by having either a recycled water producer or an area administrator interact/regulate with the users of recycled Water (permittees). The Order regulates the producers or administrators of recycled water.

The City is encouraged to consider the use of recycled water as an implementation strategy in their Plan. Current and future recycled water projects should be identified and evaluated in the DEIR. Division of Drinking Water criteria of CCR, title 22 apply. An approved Engineering Report by Division of Drinking Water is required and Individual or General Recycled Water Requirements issued by the Water Board.

BASIN PLAN

The *Water Quality Control Plan for the Lahontan Region* (Basin Plan) contains policies that the Water Board uses with other laws and regulations to protect the quality of waters of the State within the Lahontan Region. The Basin Plan sets forth water quality standards for surface water and groundwater of the Region, which include designated beneficial uses as well as narrative and numerical objectives which must be maintained or attained to protect those uses. The Basin Plan can be accessed via the Water Board's web site at:

BENEFICIAL USES

We request that the DEIR identify and specifically list each beneficial use of surface and groundwater resources at each alternative location within the Project area. An analysis of the potential impacts to water quality with respect to those beneficial uses must be included in the DEIR, and alternatives to avoid those impacts should be considered. The environmental document should summarize the measures taken to avoid and minimize environmental impacts, both permanent and temporary, for each Project alternative evaluated.

Beneficial uses of surface waters for the China Lake Hydrologic Area (Department of Water Resources Unit No. 624.20) are listed in Chapter 2, Table 2-1, of the Basin Plan. Beneficial uses for groundwater of the Indian Wells Valley (Department of Water Resources Basin No. 6-54) are listed in Chapter 2, Table 2-2, of the Basin Plan. Note that the Water Board recently removed the municipal and domestic supply (MUN) use from selected areas of the Indian Wells Valley. See: http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/lahontan/board_decisions/adopted_orders/2015/docs/r6v_2015_0005.pdf

The Project site is near Lark Seep, an ephemeral stream, and the China Dry Lake playa within the Indian Wells Hydrologic Unit of the Lahontan Region. Project impacts to the endangered Mojave Tui Chub within Lark Seep should be evaluated in the DEIR. Specific mitigation measures must be identified that, when implemented, minimize unavoidable impacts to a less than significant level to ensure that no net loss of function and value will occur as a result of Project implementation. The DEIR should identify the water quality standards that could potentially be violated by the Project and use these standards when evaluating thresholds of significance for Project impacts.

GROUNDWATER DEGRADATION ANALYSIS

The DEIR must evaluate the resulting groundwater degradation associated with each Project alternative as prescribed by the California Water Code section 13241 and State Board Resolution 68-16, such that: "any activity which produces or may produce a waste or increased volume or concentration of waste and which discharges or proposes to discharge to existing high quality waters will be required to meet WDRs which will result in the best practicable treatment or control of the discharge necessary to assure that a pollution or nuisance will not occur and the highest water quality consistent with maximum benefit to the people of the State will be maintained."

Monitoring and analysis should be performed to establish existing background water quality and an assimilative capacity analysis should be for all identified constituents of concern. During this analysis, the City should identify "Past, present, and probable future beneficial uses of water." The analysis should factor in "Water quality conditions that could reasonably be achieved through the coordinated control of all factors that affect water quality in the area."

The City/Discharger should consider how the discharge area should be monitored for degradation, and an anti-degradation analysis conducted by the Discharger should state how the present and planned discharges will prevent degradation to the groundwater to levels that would adversely affect the beneficial uses of groundwater. Degradation analysis should evaluate the effects on groundwater quality with no nitrogen removal at the wastewater treatment plant for all alternatives.

Additionally, if groundwater degradation is identified that may impair the beneficial uses, the Discharger will be required, to produce a plan to prevent impairment of the beneficial uses and/or remediate any groundwater impairment.

DREDGE/FILL IMPACTS

In areas where US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) does not take jurisdiction, the Water Board generally delineates waters of the State based on distinct geomorphic flow indicators with or without clearly definable bed and bank features. In particular, the presence or absence of traditionally "riparian vegetation" is typically not a reliable indicator of riparian zones in arid regions of California (e.g. Lark Seep). In these areas, often times the upland and riparian zones have similar vegetative communities with only subtle differences in plant density or species distribution serving as key indicators of riparian functions.

In determining appropriate mitigation ratios for impacts to waters of the State, Water Board staff considers Basin Plan requirements (minimum 1.5:1 mitigation ratio for impacts to wetlands) and utilizes 12501-SPD Regulatory Program Standard Operating Procedure for Determination of Mitigation Ratios, published December 2012 by the USACE, South Pacific Division.

Obtaining a permit and conducting monitoring does not constitute adequate mitigation. Development and implementation of acceptable mitigation is required. The environmental document must specifically describe the best management practices and other measures used to mitigate Project impacts.

HYDROMODIFICATION

Hydromodification is the alteration of the natural flow of water through a landscape (i.e. pond constructions, lining pond lining channels, etc.). Disturbing and compacting soils, changing or removing the vegetation cover, increasing impervious surfaces, and altering drainage patterns limit the natural hydrologic cycle processes of absorption, infiltration, and evapotranspiration, and increases the volume and frequency of runoff and sediment transport.

The preferred project guidelines set forth by the City should include maintaining natural drainage paths ephemeral streams within the planning area and establishing buffers and setback requirements to protect channels and floodplain areas from encroaching development. PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS

A number of activities associated with Plan implementation projects may have the potential to impact waters of the State and, therefore, may require permits issued by either the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) or Lahontan Water Board. The required permits may include:

1. Revised (for Alternative 1), or new (For Alternative 2) WDRs issued by the Water Board. A Form 200 with supporting technical information must be submitted at least 140 days prior to discharge.

2. Recycled water use for landscape irrigation may require General WDRs for Landscape Irrigation Uses of Municipal Recycled Water, WQO 2009-0006-DWQ, issued by the Lahontan Water Board, and
3. Streambed alteration and/or discharge of fill material to a surface water, including water diversions, may require a CWA, section 401 water quality certification for impacts to federal waters (waters of the U.S.), or dredge and fill WDRs for impacts to non-federal waters, both issued by the Lahontan Water Board.

We request that the DEIR recognize the potential permits that may be required, as outlined above, and identify the specific activities that may trigger these permitting actions in the appropriate sections of the environmental document.
