5. PUBLIC COMMENTS OF ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

Mr. Duong – Brought up introducing improved cycling infrastructure to the City of Ridgecrest, used the Netherlands and the City of Davis as examples. City staff will look into and bring back to committee.

Mr. Culp (asked on behalf of a citizen) - In regards, the 8/30/2021 minutes on 6.5 “*Also would like to hold off on towing vehicles until FY23 possibly FY24....*” Councilman Blades: This was for possible discussion of what could happen if cars were left in the roads... no date was set.

6. DISCUSSION ITEMS

6.1. SCE Option E Update- Reed

Option “E” work will begin late October early November and take about 2-3 weeks for completion, the workflow will begin on the Southern side and move to the Northern.

6.2. Four-way stop, Argus and Balsam- Reed

Concerns with putting in Flashing lights disturbing the surrounding neighbors, the flashing signs would not match the new aesthetic after the remodel of Balsam.

6.3. ADA Transition Plan (*Place Holder*)– Reed

6.4. Street lighting on Downs – Reed

Staff: Look into a cost estimate

6.5. Patching/ Paving Standards- Reed

Staff: Review the Cal-Trans Paving Standards to see if we hold our contractors to a reasonable standard. Look at the patching ordinance.

6.6. Lighting for Pearson Park- Reed

Pearson Park's curfew is 10pm (2200), confirmed with Parks and Recreation; Staff needs to look into lighting cost/plan for all of the parks within the City.

6.7. Wastewater Plant Update- Reed

Navy is moving forward with their pre-treatment program. The City has decided at the behest of the Water Board Mohnton Regional water control board to start progress on our portion of the pre-treatment aspect. Engineering Department will be doing survey work to confirm that all of our utilities fall with the easement, if they do not; we will work with the Navy to expand the easement.

7. COMMITTEE COMMENTS

Jinkins: Street concern for Upjohn and Norma intersection "that road is in need of repair". Reed- the Measure V Paving Project will remove 100ft on Upjohn and 50ft on Norma; to be completed in FY22.
