NEW BUSINESS

- ARPA - Shade at the KMCC Sports Complex - \$540,000 estimate to be taken to Council.
- ARPA - Turf on the Pony Field at KMCC Sports Complex – with infield \$1.4, outfield only \$1.2 million. Committee does not recommend taking to council for approval yet.

OLD BUSINESS

- Community Pool Update
 - Possibility of moving Splash Pad next to pool – Councilman Gorman – No possibility of moving the pool next to the Splash Pad. Will remain across the street where current pool and Helmers Park is.
 - Scope of the pool/Splash Pad – Currently in discussion and will be discussed further at future meetings with the communities' input
- ARPA - Approved Project Updates
 - Roof will be an additional amount due to additional work needed but will be completed within the next month.
 - Partitions are being worked on currently and the first phase complete within the next month, then will just be waiting on fabrication of new partitions for installation. Current goal is to have installed by the end of June.
- Clean CA Update
 - In the ending of the design phase and will be put out to bid hopefully by Summer.

- Per Capita Update
 - One set of shade structures have been delivered. Waiting on the second set to be delivered and then will schedule install. Will hopefully be scheduled in Summer.
