DISCUSSION AND OTHER ACTION ITEMS:

Chuck Cordell spoke of his plans for Pinney Pool. He spoke about how they have put together a group who are going to try and get Pinney pool running again. They are looking at the cost being \$500,000 combined for everything. They have a few people who are will to put in money to help with the cost. This will help bring the pool up to ADA compliant. This would be replacing the concrete, cabinets, making the bathrooms handicap accessible, repair cracking in flatwork around the pool and making other necessary repairs. Discussion took place about the procedure and having a county inspector come out and meet with Chuck Cordell on what needs to be done to bring the pool up to ADA standards. They also informed Chuck that plans would need to be drawn up as to what will be done as well as the cost and taken to council for approval. Then it will need to go to the county for plan check. So we are talking about a few months process before breaking ground can even begin. A discussion took place about the Parks and Recreation not having the operating budget for this fiscal year for the pool and that staffing would be an issue if the pool was ready by summer.

The Quality of Life committee also discussed the List of potential projects for the potential Parks District Assessment that council may pass. Mr. Patin stated that he was asked by the City manager to come up with a list and estimated costs of things that Mr. Patin knows needs to be done. He was also asked to prioritize this

list. Mr. Patin explained that we are going to be doing a survey to the public to ask them to prioritize what the public thinks are important. The committee reviewed the list of things that the Parks and Recreation Department sees as some needs for upkeep as well as regular maintenance. Some of the items are things needed now and some are just things that will come up down the road. He explained that what is in the Parks and Rec budget is just for repair nothing else. The committee discussed a few of the items on the list, and also explained more of what the assessment is for and what the benefits would be.
